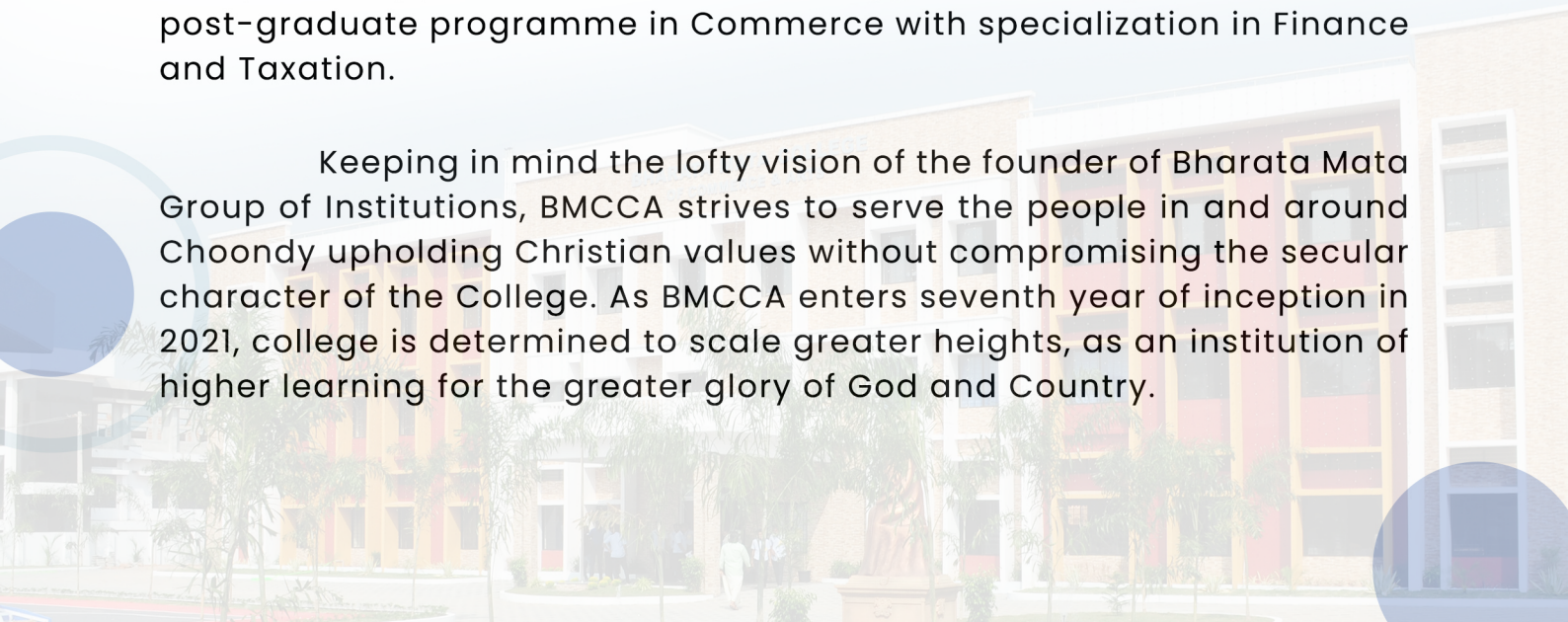

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Admission under Centralised Allotment Process of Mahatma Gandhi University (50% of sanctioned seats)

Students applying through CAP are requested to follow the notifications issued by the Mahatma Gandhi University for UG/PG admission. Accordingly they may refer to the prospectus issued by the University for the current year by visiting the official website of MGU CAP for notifications and announcements.

The details regarding eligibility, reservation etc. are mentioned in MGU prospectus

2. Admission under Management Quota

I. Those who seek admission under Management quota (UG/PG) shall have to apply separately in the prescribed form which may be collected from the office or may apply online. 50% of the total seats are allocated under Management quota. **Admissions to Management quota shall commence only after the notification is issued by MG University.**

II. Candidates who are "Eligible for Higher Studies" as per the Higher Secondary Examination and those who have passed in the equivalent examination are eligible for admission to degree (UG) programmes, unless otherwise specified.

III. Candidates who have qualified in the annual examination held in the year 2021 can apply in the management quota for UG Programmes.

IV. Students for Post Graduate program (M.com) can apply for Management quota once the notification for PG programs are notified by MG University. Students who have secured degree from the universities outside Kerala have to produce Equivalency/Recognition Certificate from MG University and Migration Certificate. Eligibility shall be as per the norms of MG University.

V. The candidates applied to various programs (UG/PG) will be ranked in the descending order of their Index mark.

VI. The rank list prepared shall be published in the college notice board and college web-site. It is the duty of the applicant to look up the selection list and attend the interview.

VII. If the applicant fails to report for interview at the time and date intimated, he/she forfeits the claim for admission.

VIII. The Calculation of Index marks (UG/PG) is as per the guidelines of MG University. Weightage will be given for NCC, NSS and the children of ex-servicemen

IX. At the time of the interview candidates should produce the following documents –

Certificates in original:

- SSLC/ Std X certificate
- Conduct Certificate
- Transfer Certificate
- Equivalency certificate (for students other than Kerala State Board, CBSE, ICSE) (for UG only)
- Migration Certificate
- Mark List of qualifying examination/Pass Certificate (Std XII Mark list)
- Relevant certificates for claiming bonus mark (NCC, NSS, Ex-servicemen, Arts etc.)
- Copy of Aadhar Card
- Degree Certificate (for PG students)
- Equivalency certificate of degree if required
- Two copies of recent passport size photograph
- Copy of SSLC or standard X certificate

10. In case of UG/PG students the pass certificate of the qualifying examination and other Certificates (Mark Lists, Transfer Certificates, and Conduct Certificate etc.) are to be surrendered to the College. The applicants are therefore advised to take sufficient number of true copies of the certificates and keep them duly attested for their interim use.

11. All admissions will be provisional subject to the verification of certificates and the approval from the University.

12. Applications which are incorrect and incomplete will be rejected.

13. For completing the Admission process in management quota, the student shall have to submit the CAP ID of MGU

14. Immediately after the interview, the candidate if selected will be enrolled on payment of the fees and submission of the certificates.

15. Each student will be given Identity card which shall be produced for all official transactions in the college and surrender it to the office on his /her leaving the college

DISCIPLINARY RULES:

All students admitted to this institution shall observe the disciplinary rules published in the Handbook and Notice Board. Any violation of these rules will result in disciplinary action, including dismissal.

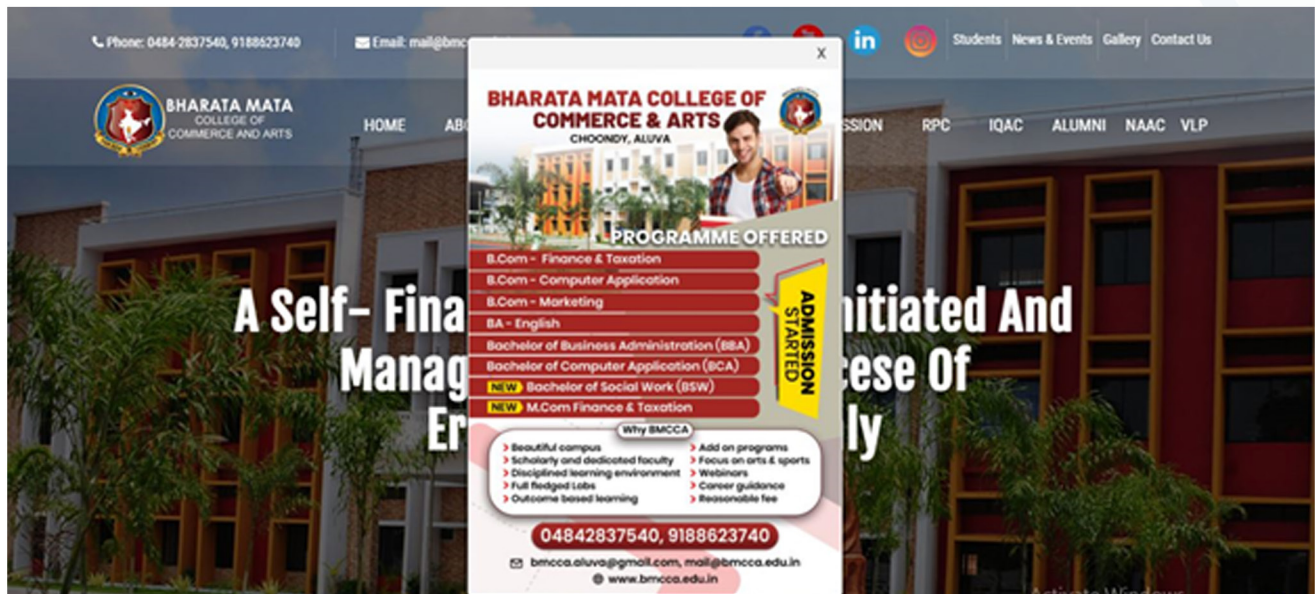

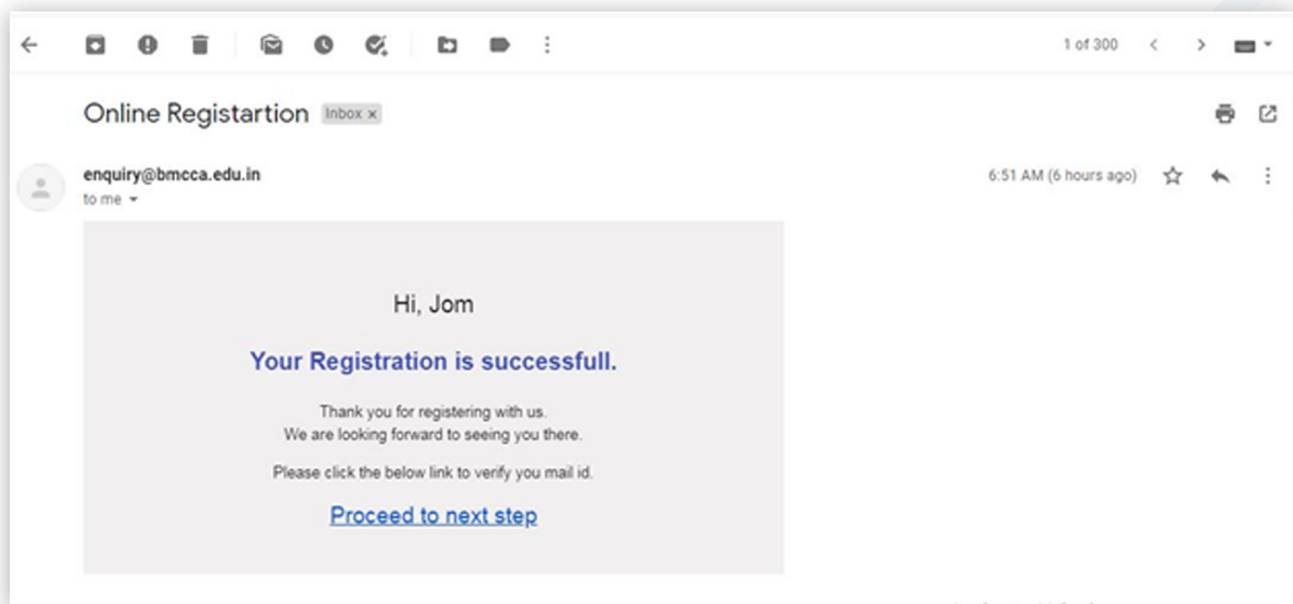
