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COLLEGE PROFILE

Bharata Mata College of Commerce and Arts (BMCCA), Choondy, Aluva, established in 2014, is a private, self-financing, co-educational institution in the unaided sector, owned and managed by the Archdiocese of Ernakulam-Angamaly.

BMCCA began its journey under the patronage of His Eminence Cardinal Mar George Alencherry, with His Excellency Mar Sebastian Adayanthrath and His Excellency Mar Jose Puthenveettil as co-patrons. The College was realized through the visionary efforts of Rev. Fr. Varghese Kalapparambath, the then Corporate Manager of the BharataMata Group of Institutions.

Affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, and approved by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Kerala, BMCCA is strategically located near Choondy Junction, making it easily accessible from Aluva, Perumbavoor, Pukkattupady and Ernakulam.

The College primarily serves socially, educationally, and economically marginalized communities in rural areas such as Vazhakkulam, Pukkattupady, Chunagamvely,

Edathala, and nearby regions. Since its inception in **August 2014,** BMCCA has expanded significantly in terms of student enrollment and infrastructure.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Admission under Centralised Allotment Process of Mahatma Gandhi University (50% of sanctioned seats)

Students applying through CAP are requested to follow the notifications issued by the Mahatma Gandhi University for UG/PG admission. Accordingly, they may refer to the prospectus issued by the University for the current year by visiting the official website of MGU CAP for notifications and announcements.

The details regarding eligibility, reservation, etc., are mentioned in the MGU prospectus.

2. Admission under Management Quota

I. Those who seek admission under Management quota (UG) shall have to apply separately in the prescribed form which may be collected from the office or may apply online. 50% of the total seats are allocated under Management quota. Admissions to Management quota shall commence only after the notification is issued by MG University.

- II. Candidates who are 'Eligible for Higher Studies' as per the Higher Secondary Examination and those who have passed the equivalent examination are eligible for admission to degree (UG) programmes, unless otherwise specified.
- III. Candidates who have qualified in the annual examination held in the year 2025 can apply in the management quota for UG Programmes.
- IV. The candidates applying for various programs (UG) will be ranked in the descending order of their Index mark.
- V. The rank list prepared shall be published on the college notice board and college website. It is the duty of the applicant to look up the selection list and attend the interview.
- VI. If the applicant fails to report for interview at the time and date intimated, he/she will forfeits the claim for admission.
- VII. The Calculation of Index marks (UG) is as per the guidelines of MG University. Weightage will be given for NCC, NSS, and the children of Ex-servicemen.
 - VIII. At the time of the interview, candidates should produce the following documents:
 - SSLC/Std X certificate
 - Conduct Certificate
 - Transfer Certificate
 - Equivalency certificate (for students other than Kerala State Board, CBSE, ICSE) (for UG only)
 - Migration Certificate
 - Mark List of qualifying examination/Pass Certificate (std XII Mark list)
 - Relevant certificates for claiming bonus mark (NCC, NSS, Ex-servicemen, Arts, etc.)
 - Copy of Aadhar Card
 - Two copies of recent passport size photograph
 - Copy of SSLC or Standard X certificate

- 3. In case of UG students, the pass certificate of the qualifying examination and other Certificates (Mark Lists, Transfer Certificates, and Conduct Certificate, etc.) are to be surrendered to the College. The applicants are therefore advised to take sufficient number of true copies of the certificates and keep them duly attested for their interim use.
- 4. All admissions will be provisional subject to the verification of certificates and the approval from the University.
- 5. Applications which are incorrect and incomplete will summarily be rejected.
- 6. For completing the admission process in the Management quota, the student shall have to submit the CAP ID of MG University.
- 7. Immediately after the interview, the candidate if selected, will be enrolled on payment of the fees and submission of the certificates.
- 8. Each student will be given an Identity card which shall be produced for all official transactions in the college and surrender it to the office on his/her leaving the College.





MANAGEMENT QUOTA PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR ADMISSION


1. Visit website www.bmcca.edu.in. Click on Admission/ Pop up image




2. Sign up and Click on next.

DISCIPLINARY RULES

All students admitted to this institution shall observe the disciplinary rules published in the Handbook and Notice Board. Any violation of these rules will result in disciplinary action, including dismissal.

Ragging is a serious criminal offence punishable under Kerala Ragging Prohibition Act 1998, with 2 years imprisonment and a penalty of Rs.10,000/-. As per the Act, if any case of ragging is reported, it will be forwarded to the local police station. The offender will be dismissed from the institution and will not be admitted to any educational institution for a period of 3 years.

Smoking and use of drugs in any form are strictly prohibited within the College premises. Smoking or selling of cigarettes, tobacco products and drugs in an area within a radius of 100 yards of the Educational institution is prohibited vide Government Order No.822/05/H. Edu. Dated 12/05/2005. Any student found indulging in the same will have to face strict disciplinary action including expulsion.


